President David welcomed twenty-seven members and friends who gathered at the Riverina Conservatorium of Music for this special meeting. Included in our number were Joan Veerhuis (guest of Peter, and Jess Linders (guest of Elle Palmer). Once again, Emily and Anthony Bosco joined us.

### **Administration Matters**

- Members are informed that at a recent Board meeting, it was determined that due to rising costs as outlined in the recent District Budget for the year ending 30 June 2024, it has been necessary to increase our annual subscription to \$300. Treasurer Nepal will contact you shortly with your invoice.
- This being a special 'off-site' meeting, most administration matters (other than a reminder from the President to register for Changeover) were held over until next meeting.

## KeyNote Speaker:

Don Pembleton's association with the Riverina Conservatorium of Music (RCM) runs deep and earned him the award of Life Membership in 2022. It was at his suggestion that our visit to the Conservatorium occurred. Don introduced members to Mr Hamish Tait, Director and CEO of the 'Con, and Dr Harold Gretton, Associate Director, who provided us with a guided tour of the new facility.



Construction of this wonderful new facility was initiated because RCM's previous home at CSU South Campus was to be sold. Property and Development NSW led the transformation of the former Roads and Maritime Services building into a state-of-the-art home for the RCM. The multi-million dollar project involved a complete 'gutting' of the building to allow for delivery of well-



designed, high-quality teaching, administration and performance spaces, including a dedicated percussion studio, 20 acoustically treated individual studios and two large rehearsal spaces. A state-of-the-art performance space with world class acoustics has also been included. Wagga is now proudly the home of a facility which is comparable to—if not the envy of—anything in the metropolitan areas.



At the conclusion of the tour, members were treated to a masterful classical guitar performance by Trang Nguyen, the very talented recipient of year's John Goldsworthy Scholarship (which is sponsored by our Club).



Afterwards, many members adjourned to the RSL Club for a Bistro meal and some 'fellowship'.

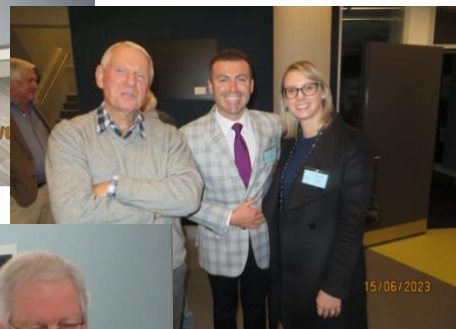
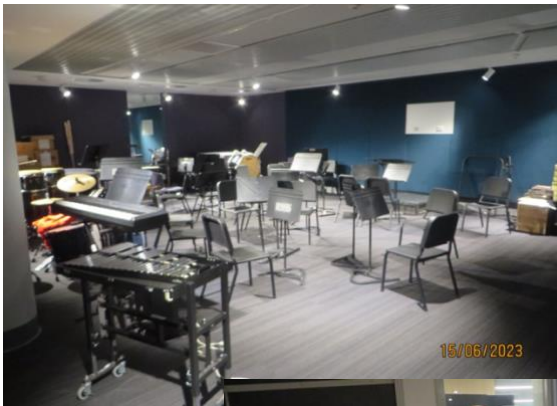
